Key words and actions

- Everyone sits on chairs in a circle

 - When you hear **2** — you move one seat to your *left*.
 - When you hear **3** — you *stand up and turn around*.
 - When you hear **4** — change chairs with someone sitting *across* from you.
 - LISTEN CAREFULLY and BE READY TO MOVE.
