Key words and actions

Treasure — with wide eyes they say, "Ooohhh!"

Captain Bigbelly — they rub their tummy and say, "Bring more food!"

Map — they pretend they are looking at an imaginary map, and say, "Hmmm"

The story

Who went to camp last year?

Well, this year we're going to **camp** again, at **camp** Nemo. And indeed, this **camp** is very different from last year's. Since last year we have found out that the **camp** was once visited by **pirates** who buried their **treasure** somewhere on the grounds.

Captain Bigbelly, who drew this map, travelled a lot and sank many ships to get his treasure; since Captain Bigbelly and his pirates had a lot of treasure, Captain Bigbelly hid the treasures he and his pirates had in several places by separating the treasure into small parts. That way, if someone found it, the treasure wouldn't all be lost.

It's interesting; he hid the **treasures** in small areas and he drew each **treasure** on a **map**, drawing only one **map** for every region where he buried **treasure**. I happened to find this **map** in the attic of an old, abandoned house I was looking through near my cottage.

Treasure Map Instructions

These instructions go along with the above story. One instruction goes with each Beaver group or lodge. You can use it at a camp or modify it to suit other needs. The "new treasure" was a mini-Scor bar (a chocolate bar) for each nugget.

1. All the points can be found on the map near the kitchen. Go there to find the different points on the map so that you know where to go. Be careful. There might be pirates following you to find the treasure for themselves. You must go to each point to find the gold. When you are finished, each nugget can be traded for a new treasure from Malak.

Note: If you find treasure that isn't marked on your instruction sheet, it's not for you. Leave it where it is.

- Go to the fire place near the lake
- · Go to the hospital
- · Go to the compass house
- · Go to the little long house
- You'll find the treasure at Hike and Trip Inc. under the kitchen.
- 2. All the points can be found on the map near the kitchen. Go there to find the different points on the map so that you know where to go. Be careful. There might be pirates following you to find the treasure for themselves. You must go to each point to find the gold. When you are finished, each nugget can be traded for a new treasure from Malak.

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- Go to the compass house
- Go to the pay phone
- Using the map, find the Northern Light, and go get the treasure there.
- 3. All the points can be found on the map near the kitchen. Go there to find the different points on the map so that you know where to go. Be careful. There might be pirates following you to find the treasure for themselves. You must go to each point to find the gold. When you are finished, each nugget can be traded for a new treasure from Malak.

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- Using the map, find the Junior Parking lot and go there.
- · Go to the Chief's office
- Using the map, find the Car wash and go get the treasure there.
- 4. All the points can be found on the map near the kitchen. Go there to find the different points on the map so that you know where to go. Be careful. There might be pirates following you to find the treasure for themselves. You must go to each point to find the gold. When you are finished, each nugget can be traded for a new treasure from Malak.

Note: If you find treasure that isn't marked on your instruction sheet, it's not for you. Leave it where it is.

- Go to the swimming waterfront, and then you can find the treasure at the baseball field
- 5. All the points can be found on the map near the kitchen. Go there to find the different points on the map so that you know where to go. Be careful. There might be pirates following you to find the treasure for themselves. You must go to each point to find the gold. When you are finished, each nugget can be traded for a new treasure from Malak.

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- Go to the valley.
- · You can find the treasure at the craft shop.
